Notes on Rainow Parish Council Working Groups

Rainow Parish Council does not have any committees with delegated authority ie all representations and decisions must be discussed and agreed in full Council meetings. The following working groups exist to report to Council meetings as required.

PLANNING GROUP

The Chairman will request Members to join site visits as needed, to visit the site of planning applications requiring comment from the Council. Visits usually take place on a Saturday morning and are agreed with the applicant. The plans are available before the start of the meeting to look at and then during the meeting, they are discussed and a comment for return to Macclesfield/Peak Park is agreed.

PROJECTS GROUP

To manage any projects taken on by the Council, getting agreement from Council as needed.

FOOTPATH GROUP

To inspect all footpaths in the Parish throughout the year and report any problems as necessary. The group also ensures that supplies of the footpath maps are provided to the outlets.

JUBILEE PLAYGROUND INSPECTION GROUP

To organise and attend monthly inspection meetings and keep records of inspections. To sort out any problems as required, with agreement from Council.

CHESHIRE ASSOCIATION – AREA MEETING REPRESENTATIVES

To attend the local meetings of the Cheshire Association of Local Councils and report back as necessary.

WEBSITE EDITOR/GROUP

The technical maintenance of the website is looked after by Jim Crowther but the editor is responsible for ensuring that all content is up to date and responding to any emails that come in from the site.
